BAR EXAMINATION REVIEW PROCEDURES

In-person Review

An unsuccessful examinee may review his or her essay answers (MEE and MPT) and the top three answers for each question at the Alabama State Bar building. Appointments are available in one-hour increments from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and from 1:30 p.m. until 3:30 p.m., and may be scheduled by calling the Admissions Office at (334) 269-1515. Requests for additional time must be made when scheduling an appointment, but examinees seldom take or need more than one hour for review.

The in-person review period for the July 2021 Bar Examination is set for November 1 - 5, 2021. Any examinee that misses a scheduled review appointment will not be rescheduled. Only the examinee, with proper photo identification, will be allowed to participate in the review of his or her answers.

Purchase of Exam Materials

An unsuccessful examinee may purchase copies of his or her answers only. The top three answers are not available for purchase. An examinee who wishes to purchase a copy of his or her answers must submit a written request within 60 days after the announcement of bar examination results. The request must include the question number for each requested answer (i.e., MEE 1-6 and MPT 1-2). The request must be accompanied by a check or money order, made payable to the Alabama State Bar (\$5.00 per answer; \$40.00 for all answers).
